



COVID VACCINATION ADVICE FOR ROWLEY RESIDENTS

Every Massachusetts Resident aged 6 months and up is eligible to be vaccinated against COVID-19. Vaccination is a highly effective preventative against serious illness or death from the virus.

HOW TO GET VACCINATED

CALL YOUR PRIMARY CARE PHYSICIAN: Call your doctor if you have any questions as to whether you should be vaccinated. Ask whether your provider can vaccinate you. If your provider is not doing vaccinations, there are other resources.

VETERANS: The Department of Veterans Affairs has urged all Veterans to consider being vaccinated as a way to continue to serve the USA. All Veterans may be vaccinated at VA healthcare facilities whether or not they are eligible for VA healthcare, along with their spouses and caregivers. GO TO:
