## Rowley Cultural Council needs volunteers to continue to receive state funding for the town

The Rowley Cultural Council receives funding from the Massachusetts Cultural Council to re-grant funds to individuals and organizations in their own community. The Rowley Cultural Council is made up of volunteers who are appointed by the Board of Selectmen and are responsible for making decisions on how they will award the funds granted to them by the Massachusetts Cultural Council in ways that will serve the local cultural needs.

A willingness to serve the community is all that is needed. Without a minimum of five (5) volunteers the town will not receive their annual allotment from the Massachusetts Cultural Council to disburse to local organizations and individuals to support cultural arts in our town.
