- Enforcement Order(s) at 165/175 Glen Street (Map 20, Parcel 17, Lots 6 and 6-1) also 27/29 Coleman Road, Newbury MacCausland/Senecal and contractor Artistic Landscapes: Cutting, clearing, and grading (altering), placement of fill (filling), and ditching (removal) in Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW) 310 CMR 10.55 and within the 100' Buffer Zone of BVW 310 CMR 10.02 of approx. 500 - 800 sq. ft. (state & local). Possible alteration of an intermittent stream (Bank) 310 CMR 10.54) by redirecting groundwater flow. All without application or issued permit (WPA or Local Bylaw).
