NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act, Town of Rowley Wetlands Protection Bylaw, and Stormwater Management and Erosion Control Bylaw

Notice: You are hereby notified that you or your agents may have violated Massachusetts' environmental laws with regards to the provisions of the Wetlands Protection Act, as well as Town of Rowley Wetlands Protection Bylaw. The Wetlands Protection Act and the local bylaw apply to all wetland resource areas within the Town of Rowley, including all private property.

Reported Activity: Grading and clearing associated with construction of a gravel storage yard and vehicle storage with access drive in the DEP Approved Groundwater Protection Area Zone II and the 100' Buffer Zone without obtaining a Wetlands Permit and altering with disturbance exceeding 20,000 square feet of surface area without a Stormwater Mgt. permit.

In order to determine if a violation has occurred we request that you comply with all of the following requests:

- Cease any alteration or work relative to the Reported Activity above.
- Immediately contact the Conservation Commission at (978) 948-2330 to schedule a site visit.
- Schedule a time to attend the next Commission meeting on November 15, 2022, which is held remotely

If you do not understand the requirements of the Wetlands Protection Act or the Town of Rowley Wetlands Protection Bylaw, the Conservation Commission and its staff will make every effort to assist you in complying with the law.
