- A written statement (submit original signature) from a Registered Professional Engineer of the Commonwealth certifying that the work has been completed in completion with this SMP, documents, and the approved plans referenced herein (or approved revisions). Any discrepancies or deviations shall be noted and explained.
- An as-built topographic plan of the same scale as the approved plan, signed and stamped by a Registered Professional Engineer or Land Surveyor of the Commonwealth, showing post-construction conditions for the public record. This plan will include as built elevations of all drainage ways, distances to all structures, and all elevations. This as-built plan may be the originally submitted final approved site plan with changes highlighted and explained.
- Email an electronic PDF copy of all documents to <u>conservation@townofrowley.org</u>. All documents and plans will be provided as separate electronic files for record management purposes.
- Any additional materials which may be required under the Stormwater Management Permit. Please read the SMP to determine <u>all</u> requirements to obtain a Certificate of Completion.

Dear Commission Members:

In accordance with Conditions 8 & 18 of the Stormwater Management Permit issued on August 31, 2017, find enclosed an As-Built Site Conditions plan & a SMP Form A – Request for Certificate of Completion for the above-referenced project as well as the \$200 fee.

I hereby certify that all work has been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans as revised and the Stormwater Management Permit with the following minor exceptions:

- The approved deck and steps behind the restaurant, 4' wide stone dust path and associated overlook area on the southern half of the site were not constructed.
- A stockade fence was constructed around the generator and HVAC pads along the southern face of the restaurant approximately 34' from WF A15.
- Approximately 145 LF of additional post and rail fencing was installed to the south and east of the restaurant and associated patio.
- A shed (166 SF±) was constructed to the southeast of the restaurant.

The above referenced changes should have no measurable impact on the stormwater design of the lot and should have no measurable impact to the abutters or the resource areas.

At this time, we ask that the Commission issue a Certificate of Completion for this project. If you should have any questions regarding this matter, please do not hesitate to contact our office.
